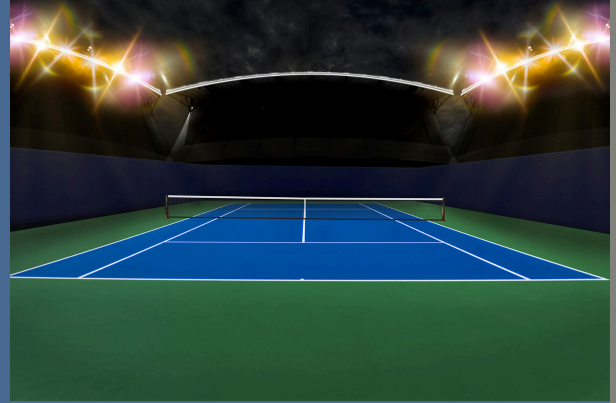
Mens and Ladies Singles- 9am start

REMINDERS

We love seeing our courts so busy and full of life. However, we need a small collective effort to keep our facilities safe, tidy, and in top condition for everyone. Please take note of these quick reminders.

Clay Court Brushes: After sweeping the courts, please always hang the drag mats and brushes back up on their designated fence hooks- please see photo below. Leaving them lying on the ground damages the bristles and creates a tripping hazard for the next players.

Locking Up: If you are the last person leaving the club or if the courts and clubhouse are completely empty when you finish you must lock the padlock gates and securely close the clubhouse door. Thank you all for doing your part to keep our club safe, secure, and looking its best!

Courts 2 and 3 Gate: Just a reminder to please ensure you wipe your feet if moving between Courts 2 and 3. This gate is only for use to retrieve balls and not as a route to Courts 3 and 4 as this leads to clay being spread onto the synthetic grass courts.
