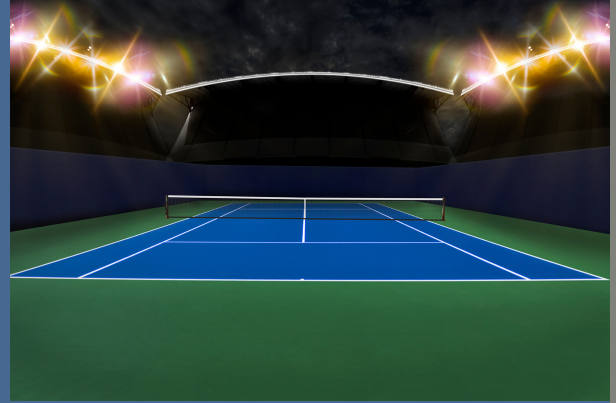
Mens and Ladies Singles- 9am start
